For spring type mouth gags for use in dogs, they normally come with hard plastic tips that easily slip off the cusps of canines and premolars.

We strongly recommend removing these and replacing them with soft rubber Vacutainer<sup>™</sup> caps so they do not slip off the cusps of teeth. These will hold well even on premolars, when one or more canine teeth is missing.

Place the caps with a press fit so that when they become worn, you can simply replace them.

Be careful not to overextend the temporomandibular joints with this type of mouth gag, and remove a portion of the spring if necessary.
